10. Port Corporation: Mayor Penwell had a conversation with Earl Rose regarding the ongoing wharf construction. Mr. Rose advised Mayor Penwell that the engineers came to inspect the area on Monday & noticed that the road by the customs building/wharf is actually going to be 10-11 inches below; therefore, they will have to lift a couple basins and bring them up about 14 inches. All repairs will be covered by the Fortune Port Corporation.

11. Asphalt Recycler: Deputy Mayor Smith advised Council that he had received an inquiry from a resident wondering if the Town of Fortune would be willing to rent the asphalt recycler by the hour & to hire one of the Public Works Employees (outside of work hours) to pave a 10X10 driveway. The Town of Fortune has previously paved patches for residents; however, only up to a maximum of 50 SQ FT.

A discussion surfaced amongst the Councillors present & \$75/per hour to rent the asphalt recycler deemed to be reasonable; however, cost for labour for one of Public Works Employees to operate the machinery would be the responsibility of the resident renting the equipment with no liability on accident or inquiry to the Town of Fortune.

Councillor Kendell recommending sending an email regarding this matter to all Council for their opinion before any approval or decision is made.
